


Monthly LBTT Update – December 2019

- **Total LBTT:** LBTT generated £64.6m in December 2019, the highest monthly outturn since the tax was established in April 2015. Revenue was up by £9.2m (17%) compared to the same month in 2018 and increased by £13.2m (26%) on the total for November 2019. So far this tax year revenues have been £53.1m (12%) higher than recorded at the same stage in 2018/19.
- **Non-Residential LBTT**: Non-residential LBTT revenues recovered in December 2019 after a particularly low outturn in November. At £19.4m, non-residential receipts generated £8.5m (78%) more than the previous month but were £3m (13%) less than in December 2018. In the current tax year to date, total non-residential LBTT revenue is £8.7m (6%) lower than for the same period in 2018/19.
- **Residential LBTT**: The residential element of the tax also set new highs in December. At £30.4m, residential revenue was up by £6.4m (27%) on the total for December 2018 and £4.1m (16%) on November 2019's total. Residential LBTT revenues are £20.9m (10%) higher in 2019/20 than during the same period in 2018/19.
- **ADS:** Revenues from the additional dwellings supplement increased in December to £14.8m, up from £14.1m in November and £9m in December 2018. However, ADS revenue will be revised downwards over the coming months as taxpayers have 18 months to claim repayments. Around 22% of the total ADS liability has been repaid since the charge was introduced in April 2016.
